This hourly position reports to the Manager of Operations and performs all work relating to installing, testing and replacing electric meters, metering equipment, related electrical instruments and monthly inspections of substations. Must be a journeyman meterman and possess leadership qualifications required to have full charge of employees classified as journeyman and apprentice meterman. Responsible for crew safety, progress and quality of work, and compliance with OTEC policies, procedures, construction standards, safety manual and other applicable regulations. Must have supervisor experience and the ability to train and instruct others as required . Experience with TWACS metering a plus.

Applicants are required to have a high school diploma or the equivalent plus successful completion of an approved apprenticeship program for an electrical meterman and OSHA 1910.269 training. Must possess a valid Oregon driver's license. Applicants are required to reside no more than 14 miles from the Baker district headquarters.
