

WHAT TO DO IF YOUR POWER IS INTERRUPTED

Check your circuit breakers and if they're okay, call us immediately at any of the following numbers:

OTEC crews are on call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days per year. We take your need for electricity seriously.

1. Call OTEC if you have a power outage. If the phone lines are busy, please keep trying.
2. In the unlikely event of a downed power line, DO NOT attempt to move it or touch it! Keep everyone away. Call OTEC or the police. Professional, highly trained personnel will respond immediately.
3. DO NOT plug portable home electric generators into a wall outlet. Our servicemen could be injured, **FATALLY** by the back-feed of electricity through your home's electrical system.
4. If it appears that the outage will be a long one, unplug your appliances; (especially heat pumps, water heaters, freezers, furnace fans, and refrigerators) or turn the power off at the circuit panel. After power is restored, turn them back on, individually, and spaced over a 30 minute period.
5. If some of your lights appear to be dim when the power comes back on, call OTEC.
6. Remember that unopened freezers will remain at freezing temperature for up to 48 hours.
